Planning

- 150A Waterside Road has put in planning for a single storey extension.
- 11 Waterside gardens have put in planning to raise the roof and add a 2 and a half story extension.
- One home on Busby road plot has put new house plans. These are different from the original plans that have been approved thus can be rejected and opposed on the original issues (green belt etc). Date for comment had elapsed.

Roads and Lighting

- Marion has taken pictures of blocked drains for the councillors to see.
- What potholes have been filled in the village less than a month ago are already crumbling away.
- Old police house is experiencing flooding due to blocked and insufficient drains - John will pass to councillors.
- The drains need cleared more often. GCC have reintroduced drain cleaning programme.
- No evidence yet that Craigsheen/ Picketlaw drains cleared
- Fly tipping at Pedmyre lane - council has now collected all rubbish and slabs. Quick response to last two reports
- Waterside road is still in a very dangerous condition. Please drive carefully.

Transport

Marion is still waiting to hear back from FirstBus about bringing the 75 or similar up to Carmunnock. John had posted, on FB, details of the SPT consultation and asked as many as possible to complete survey.
