Finance:

The Community Council Fund stood at £6863.22. There was a spend on the Remembrance Wreath and printing of Christmas Booklet

The CCC are awaiting the loan to the Castlemilk hall committee to be repaid.

Planning

- The Castlemilk hall have applied to erect an extension to the side of the Castlemilk hall which the CCC support.
- 13 Manse Road applied for new doors to be put in.

Roads and Lighting

- Bailie Morgan is going to chase up the repairs needed on the road down to croftfoot.
- John has been told the jobs reported on the MyGlasgow app get signed off without actually being completed to improve statistics. Could all residents continue to report on the app and if the issue is not resolved report to the local councillors.
- Councillor Carson and McCabe have reported the pot holes down Carmunnock road.
- The gully cleaning did not take place, only street cleaning.
- Carson is going to chase up Vallis in regard to Margarets pictures taken of drains throughout the village.
- Flooding from the drains on Carigsheen avenue continues to be a problem. Craigsheen and Busby road continue to flood and freeze over making very dangerous walking and driving conditions. This has been amplified by the recent increased parking in this area. Councillor McCabe is going to look into further actions around the drains flooding.
- Councillor Carson is going to enquire as to why Carmunnock didn't meet the exemption of pavement parking.
- The recent changes in parking regulations along with ongoing parking issues within Carmunnock have raised the proposal for certain roads to get double yellow lines. We are still in discussion about this and more feedback from residents is needed.

Transport

- No new updates.

Linn Area Committee

- The latest meeting was cancelled. There is no grant money left. The next meeting will be held in February.

AOB

- John, after years of reporting fly tipping, investigated the outcome of those who have been caught fly tipping. He found that in 5 years no one has been taken to court around fly tipping. The Council alternative was to issue Fixed Penalty Notices. The statistics on these should an extremely high level of non-payment.
- Rev David McGee has been adopted as an associate member.
- The tree lighting will be on the 5th of December.
- Adran (on behalf of the PTA at Carmunnock primary) came to the meeting to discuss with the CC about applying for money to create an outdoor learning area at the primary school. Co McCabe informed him that the money would be coming from NIF (the neighbourhood infrastructure fund) and to check his proposals meet their requirements. The funding was approved by the CC and John will send the request over to the Linn Area Committee.
- Heidi is awaiting confirmation of funding from changing places to add to the renovation costs to the Castlemilk hall.
- There has been a car with police tape and fly tipping at the entrance to the Carnbooth hotel.
- Councillor McCabe has been enquiring about getting boulders put at the start of pedmyre lane to reduce fly tipping. He is also going to send a map of ownership to John.
- Councillor Carson is going to enquire about the cost of fixing/replacing a drain.
- The councillors have asked if residents can email them with any concerns or issues they are facing. The more voices that are given to these issues allows the councillors to push action further. The email addresses are:
