Woodland Visitors

Sophie and Jill attended the meeting from the Woodland trust. They came to ask our opinion and preferences on what should be done with the wood from the coppice. They informed us that willow from Carmunnock will be planted at Ibrox stadium as well as in Netherlee. They have a permit to use the wood for three years currently. They are looking to build connections with the Gardening group, Carmunnock primary as well as the community council. On the 2nd of April there will be a third class on how to work with the wood.

Planning

- 6 Windlaw Road has applied for a single-story extension consisting of a conservatory and back porch.
- 35 Hillcrest have applied for the creation of a driveway. Neighbours have noted their objection to this.

- Bailie Morgan is going to chase the cutting back of the shrubbery on Busby road.
